


Message from Senator Kearney


Assistance for Small Businesses

The SBA has announced the Paycheck Protection Program is now open for applications! This loan is designed to help small businesses keep their workers on the payroll. SBA will forgive loans if all employees are kept on the payroll for eight weeks and the money is used for payroll, rent, mortgage interest, or utilities.
