
## Message from Senator Kearney

- DRIVE-THRU AND WALK-UP TESTING FOR ALL RESIDENTS 12 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.
- TESTING CONDUCTED BY TRAINED MEDICAL STAFF UTILIZING A NASAL SWAB (PCR) TEST KIT.
- AVAILABLE FOR THOSE WHO HAVE COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19, OR WHO MAY BE ASYMPTOMATIC.
- OPEN TO ALL RESIDENTS AND INDIVIDUALS WHO WORK IN DELAWARE COUNTY, WITH ESSENTIAL WORKERS GIVEN PRIORITY.
- AVAILABLE FOR BOTH INSURED AND UNINSURED RESIDENTS. THERE ARE NO OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES OR CO-PAYS FOR THOSE WITH HEALTH INSURANCE. PLEASE BRING YOUR INSURANCE CARD TO THE TEST SITE.
- DOCTOR'S PRESCRIPTION NOT REQUIRED.
- TEST RESULTS WILL TAKE UP TO 5-7 BUSINESS DAYS.
- RESIDENTS MUST WEAR A MASK/FACE COVERING AT TEST SITE.
