Unemployment Assistance



Individuals who have lost their jobs due to COVID-19 can now file for an additional 11 weeks of benefits:

Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) assists workers who have exhausted their regular Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits. Payments will resume this week, and you can file your claim now. More info here.

Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) assists workers who are not typically eligible for other unemployment compensation programs, including gig workers, freelancers, and self-employed workers. You can now file for the weeks of January 2, 9, 16, and 23. You must file by this Friday, January 29. More info here.
