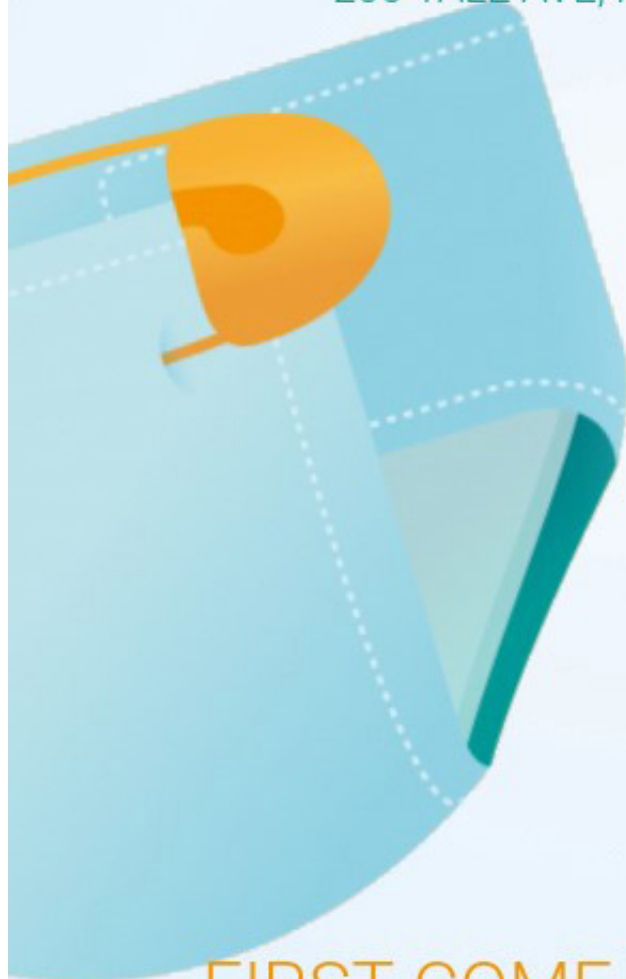

- DRIVE-THRU AND WALK-UP TESTING FOR ALL RESIDENTS 12 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.
- TESTING WILL BE CONDUCTED BY TRAINED MEDICAL STAFF UTILIZING A NASAL SWAB (PCR) TEST KIT.
- TESTING IS FREE OF CHARGE FOR RESIDENTS WITHOUT HEALTH INSURANCE. NO OUT-OF-POCKET FEE OR CO-PAY FOR RESIDENTS WITH PRIVATE OR PUBLIC HEALTH INSURANCE. PLEASE BRING YOUR INSURANCE CARD TO THE TESTING SITE.
- WALK-UP TESTING ALSO AVAILABLE.
- TEST RESULTS WILL TAKE UP TO 5-7 BUSINESS DAYS.
- ESSENTIAL WORKFORCE - FIRST RESPONDERS, HEALTHCARE EMPLOYEES, GROCERY WORKERS, ETC. - WILL BE GIVEN PRIORITY.
- PLEASE WEAR A MASK/FACE COVERING UPON ARRIVAL.

Hazard Pay for Frontline Workers

HAZARD PAY GRANT PROGRAM

*As part of Act 2A of 2020, \$50,000,000 was appropriated from CARES Act funding to the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) to provide **Hazard Pay** for **FRONTLINE WORKERS**.*

<p><u>ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Businesses • Healthcare Non-Profit • Public Transportation Agency • A Certified Economic Development Organization (CEDO) 	<p><u>ELIGIBLE USE OF FUNDS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hazard pay will be made to full-time employees earning less than \$18 and hour, excluding fringe benefits and overtime, as a direct increase in pay • The direct increase in pay for a frontline worker will be \$3.00 per hour for ten-weeks for a total of \$1,200

*Applications will be open for a two-week window beginning on **July 16, 2020** and closing on **July 31, 2020**. Eligible applicants will apply on behalf of the frontline workers in eligible industries.*



Our lowest-paid frontline workers have risked their own health to keep us safe and fed. Now, they are eligible for \$50 million in grant funding for hazard pay. Apply online through July 31 at: www.esa.dced.state.pa.us
