Progress in Pennsylvania



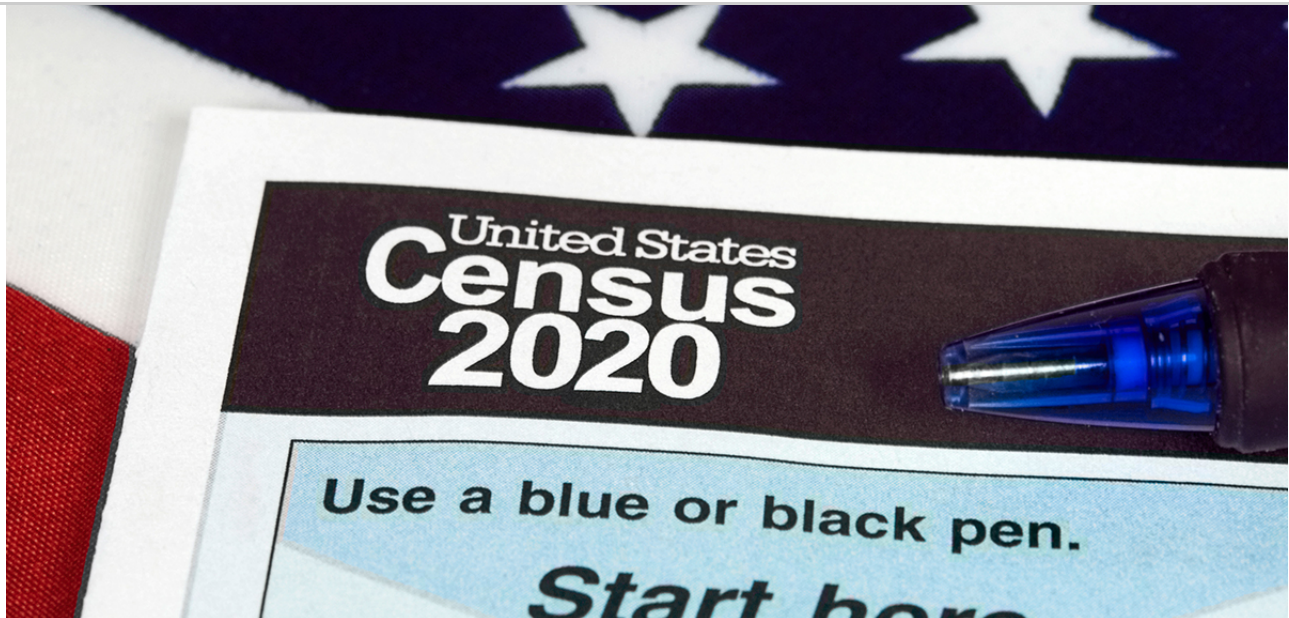
Pennsylvania is *one of just three states* that has had a downward trajectory of COVID-19 cases for *more than 42 days*.
