TODAY: Moving to Green

Southeast Region

Moving from Yellow to Green on **June 26**

(Schuylkill County moved to Green on June 19)

Work & Congregate Setting Restrictions:

- Continued Telework Strongly Encouraged;
- Businesses with In-Person Operations Must Follow Updated Business and Building Safety Requirements;
- All Businesses Operating at 50% Occupancy in the Yellow Phase May Increase to 75% Occupancy;
- Child Care May Open Complying with Guidance;
- Congregate Care Restrictions in Place;
- Prison and Hospital Restrictions Determined by Individual Facilities;
- Schools Subject to CDC and Commonwealth Guidance.

Social Restrictions:

- Large Gatherings of More Than 250 Prohibited;
- Restaurants and Bars Open at 50% Occupancy;
- Personal Care Services (including hair salons and barbershops) Open at 50% Occupancy and by Appointment Only;
- Indoor Recreation, Health and Wellness Facilities, and Personal Care Services (such as gyms and spas) Open at 50% Occupancy with Appointments Strongly Encouraged;
- All Entertainment (such as casinos, theaters, and shopping malls) Open at 50% Occupancy. Construction Activity May Return to Full Capacity with Continued Implementation of Protocols.

Today, Delaware and Chester Counties will move to the green phase of reopening. Your actions have saved lives and slowed the spread of COVID-19. Even with fewer restrictions, we still need to use caution. [Following safety guidelines](#) will help revive our economy and prevent a resurgence. Stay safe and remember – we’re all in this together.





Police Reforms Pass Senate



POLICE REFORMS PASS SENATE

-  **SB 1205**
 Bans the use of chokeholds & requires police to adopt use-of-force standards
-  **SB 459**
 Mandates reporting of all use-of-force incidents



On Wednesday, the Senate unanimously passed two bills that ban chokeholds, require police to adopt use-of-force standards, and mandate reporting of use-of-force incidents. These bills now go to the House. The work is not over, but this is an important step on the long road to justice.
