# Senate Bill 1122

- ✓ \$50 million for Fire & EMS
- ✓ Senator Kearney's proposal to allow VFRA funds for COVID-19 expenses



Volunteer fire and EMS companies are keeping us safe but struggling financially during this pandemic. I am proud to announce the General Assembly unanimously passed Senate Bill 1122, which Governor Tom Wolf has signed into law, that includes \$50 million in grant funding for fire and EMS services. This bill also includes my proposal with Senator Pam Iovino to allow Volunteer Firefighter Relief Association funds to be used for COVID-19 expenses.
