
It's been one year since Breonna Taylor was killed. She should be alive today.


Our work isn't done to ensure a tragedy like this never happens again. Breonna's Law – my bill to ban no-knock warrants in Pennsylvania – didn't come up for a vote in the last legislative session. But I'm not giving up the fight.

I have <u>re-introduced Breonna's Law</u> and it has been referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee. The committee will decide whether they will debate the bill and pass it to the full Senate.

Here's how you can help:


- Contact your state legislators and ask them to support Senate Bill 296
