Dear friend,

It's been one year since Breonna Taylor was killed. She should be alive today.

Our work isn't done to ensure a tragedy like this never happens again. Breonna's Law – my bill to ban no-knock warrants in Pennsylvania – didn't come up for a vote in the last legislative session. But I'm not giving up the fight.

I have [re-introduced Breonna's Law](#) and it has been referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee. The committee will decide whether they will debate the bill and pass it to the full Senate.

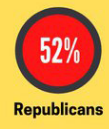
