Driver and Vehicle Services

What if my driver's license, photo ID card, learner's permit or camera card is scheduled to expire?

Driver licenses, photo ID cards, learner's permits and camera cards scheduled to expire from March 16, 2020 through May 31, 2020 now have an extended expiration date of **June 30, 2020**.
