


Message from Senator Kearney

Tuesday, June 2 is Primary Election Day in Pennsylvania. Your vote is your voice, so please make sure to participate in our democracy. Below you will find information on how to safely vote in Tuesday's election. Stay safe and stay healthy – and be a prepared voter!



How to Return Your Ballot



Your mail-in ballot must be **received** by your county election office by **8:00 pm on June 2** (Election Day). Worried about your ballot arriving on time? Here are ways to return your ballot:

DELAWARE COUNTY

You can deliver your ballot to the Delaware County Government Center (201 W. Front Street in Media). There will be a drop box inside the door. Drop-off times:

- Monday-Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm
- Saturday, May 30 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm



You can also deliver your ballot on Election Day at any polling place in Delaware County. There will be a drop box inside each polling place. Check updated polling locations here: <u>www.delcopa.gov/pdf/2020PrimaryConsolidation.pdf</u>

CHESTER COUNTY

You can deliver your ballot to the Chester County Government Services Center (601 Westtown Road in West Chester) any time until 8:00 pm on June 2. There will be a drop box in the lobby. If you drop off your ballot outside regular business hours (8:30 am to 4:30 pm), please buzz at the door and the guard will let you in.

What If I Didn't Receive My Ballot?



If you applied for a mail-in ballot **but didn't receive it in time**, you can complete a provisional ballot at your polling location (*see below*). Your provisional ballot will be counted when your county election office confirms that your requested mail-in ballot was not returned.

Voting in Person



If you want to vote in person, polls will be open on June 2 from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. Due to COVID-19, several polling locations have been consolidated for the primary election. Please check to see if your polling location has changed:
